THE OBJECT of this suit is to obtain a decree of divorce a vinculo matrimonii from the Defendant, Moses W. White.

The Bill in substance states that the Plaintiff and Defendant were lawfully married by a Minister of the Gospel at Prince George's County, Md., on November 25th, 1909. That the Plaintiff has been a resident of the State of Maryland for more than two years before the filing of this Bill. That the Defendant is a non-resident of the State of Maryland, residing in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, according to the last information of Plaintiff. That there are no children living as a result of said marriage. That the conduct of the Plaintiff towards the Defendant was always kind and affectionate and above reproach; but that the Defendant, without any just cause or excuse, did desert and abandon the Plaintiff on or about July 4th, 1919; and that the separation of the parties has continued uninterruptedly since the 4th of July, 1919, and down to the filing of this suit; and that the desertion by the Defendant was willful and deliberate and there is no reasonable hope or expectation of reconciliation. The Bill prays for a divorce a vinculo matrimonii and for an order of publication against the defendant and for further relief.

It is thereupon this 27th day of September, 1922, ordered by the Circuit Court for Prince George's County, Maryland, in Equity, that the Plaintiff, by causing a copy of this order to be published in a newspaper published in Prince George's County, Maryland, once in each of four successive weeks before the 8th day of November, 1922, give notice to the said Moses W. White Defendant, of the object and substance of this Bill, and warn him the Defendant to be and appear in this Court on or before the 23rd day of November, 1922, to answer the Bill of Complaint and show cause, if any he has, why a decree of divorce should not be passed as prayed.
