AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE the flow of traffic on Main Street. The purpose of this Ordinance, is to provide for the reasonable flow of traffic for the convenience and safety of the public.

SECTION I.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Town Commissioners for the Town of Upper Marlboro, that a new Ordinance, Ordinance 02-06 be and hereby is, enacted and shall read as follows:

SECTION II.

"A. DEFINITIONS

- (1) U-turn is defined as a turn resulting in a vehicle going in the opposite direction after a turning maneuver.
- (2) Illegal backing is defined as backing into a main thoroughfare rather than entering in a forward direction.

B. UNLAWFUL TURNS

- (1) No person shall execute a U-turn on Main Street, also known as Route 725 and also known as Marlboro Pike between the intersection at Governor Oden Bowie Drive and 14504 Main Street.

(2) No person shall back onto Main Street, also known as Route 725, also known as Marlboro Pike.

C. PENALTIES


Any person engaging in a U-turn or backing onto Main Street shall be subject to a penalty of not more than \$100.00."


SECTION III.


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its adoption by the Town of Upper Marlboro, Maryland.


