AN ACT TO AMEND ORDINANCE 76-1, Motor Vehicle Parking and Traffic Control, by adding paragraph 1-29 to Article 3, entitled "Handicapped Parking" and by adding paragraph 1-38(h) to Article 5 under "Penalties."

SECTION I. BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners for the Town of Upper Marlboro, that Ordinance 76-1 be and hereby is amended by adding paragraph 1-29 to Article 3 and by adding paragraph 1-38(h) to Article 5 by inserting the following language.

SECTION II.

"1-29. Handicapped Parking

A person to whom handicapped plates or permits have been issued by this state or any other state may park in a parking space equipped with a parking meter only for twice the maximum time period permitted on the parking meter."

and under Penalties

"(h) A person to whom handicapped plates or permits have been issued by this state or any other state and who parks in a parking space equipped with a meter for more than twice the maximum time period permitted on the parking meter shall be subject to a ^{FIVE}TEN AND

SECTION III. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Amendment to Ordinance 76-1 shall take effect 20 days after its adoption by the Town of Upper Marlboro, Maryland.
