ORDINANCE: 93-2
SESSION: Regular
DATE: May 11, 1993

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR the unobstructed passage of traffic, whether pedestrian or vehicular, unless any detour or delay is approved by the Board of Town Commissioners or in the event of an emergency. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for the reasonable free flow of traffic and convenience of the public.

SECTION 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Town Commissioners for the Town of Upper Marlboro, that Ordinance 93-2 be and hereby is, enacted and shall read as follows.

SECTION 2.

"A. DEFINITIONS

1. An emergency is defined as an unplanned and unscheduled event endangering life, limb, or human safety.

2. Buses shall be defined as vehicles capable of carrying more than seven (7) members of the public.

B.

1. It shall be unlawful for any person, business, or utility company to obstruct the free flow of traffic for any purpose unless prior approval has been granted by the Board of Town Commissioners or unless it is deemed as an emergency as defined above.

2. No buses shall use residential streets of the Town of

Upper Marlboro. This ordinance does not apply to buses transporting children to and from school or buses in use solely for the convenience of the elderly.

3. No person or property owner shall change the access from any property within the town into a street or disturb the pavement without first getting the approval of the Board of Town Commissioners.

C. PENALTIES

1. Any person, business, or utility violating this statute shall be subject to a fine of not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars."

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its adoption by the Town of Upper Marlboro, Maryland.





LEGAL NOTICES
The Board of Town Commissioners for the Town of Upper Marlboro has recently enacted two ordinances as follows:
Ordinance 93-1 regulates special events within the Town and sets policy for the number of special events authorized per month and when. Sets fine of \$500.00 for violations. Ordinance becomes effective May 31, 1993.
Ordinance 93-2 makes it unlawful to obstruct the free flow of traffic unless prior approval granted by Board of Town Commissioners, or unless deemed emergency as defined. Prohibits use of residential streets by certain buses; prohibits changing access into a street or disturbing pavement without prior approval of Board of Town Commissioners. Sets fine of \$500.00 for violation of statute. Ordinance becomes effective May 31, 1993.
